NIGERIAN NATIONAL DEFENCE COLLEGE TEAM ON STUDY TOUR OF JAMAICA

Senior officials from the National Defence College (NDC) in Nigeria, the primary military training institution for the Nigerian Armed Forces, paid a Courtesy Call on Senator the Hon. Arnold J. Nicholson, QC, Minister of Foreign Affairs & Foreign Trade, on Wednesday, May 13.

The team is in the island for a one week study tour, under the theme “*Agriculture and National Development in Jamaica: Lessons for Nigeria*”. The group of 23, including senior officials of the College, arrived last Friday (May 8), and will be here until the weekend, as part of their yearly Geo-Strategic World Study Tour.

With the aim of gaining insight into the role of state institutions in Jamaica’s national development, the team has so far toured the Jamaica Defence Force Headquarters; the Moneague Training Camp; and the Jamaica Police Academy, Twickenham Park, St. Catherine. They participated in presentations from the Ministry of Agriculture & Fisheries; the Planning Institute of Jamaica (PIOJ); and the Ministry of Industry, Investment and Commerce (MIIC).
